## On this day – 24<sup>th</sup> October

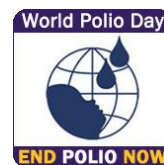
- 1260 – The Cathedral of Chartres was dedicated in the presence of *King Louis IX of France*; the cathedral is now a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- 1812 – Napoleonic Wars: The Battle of Maloyaroslavets took place near Moscow.
- 1857 – Sheffield F.C., the world's oldest association football club still in operation, was founded
- 1901 – *Annie Edson Taylor* became the first person to go over Niagara Falls, in a barrel.
- 1917 – Bolshevik Red Guards began the takeover of buildings in Russia, among the first events associated with the October Revolution.
- 1926 – *Harry Houdini's* last performance took place at the Garrick Theatre in Detroit.
- 1943 – The Provisional Government of Free India formally declared war on Britain and the United States of America.
- 1945 – Founding of the United Nations.
- 1949 – The cornerstone of the United Nations Headquarters was laid.
- 1964 – Northern Rhodesia gained independence from the United Kingdom and became the Republic of Zambia.
- 1992 – The Toronto Blue Jays became the first Major League Baseball team based outside the United States to win the World Series.
- 2003 – Concorde made its last commercial flight.
- 2008 – "Bloody Friday" saw many of the world's stock exchanges experience the worst declines in their history, with drops of around 10% in most indices.
